IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Board accepts, adopts and incorporates herein by reference the Stipulated Settlement Agreement between Enforcement and the Permit holder in the above-captioned matter and further that the violation set forth and charged in the Complaint dated April 20, 2010, issued by the Board in the above-captioned matter is sustained and the Permit holder shall pay a total monetary penalty of sixty dollars (\$60) for the above-referenced


1 violation. The Permit holder shall pay the monetary penalty within thirty (30) days of the date

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General and the MAST Permit Holder, CHRYSTAN RILEY-WILLIAMS hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,627.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Permit Holder, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 3C9346B, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

That on or about December 12, 2009, the above-named MAST Permit Holder, sold, allowed, and/or permitted an apparently intoxicated person(s) to consume liquor and/or possess liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200 and/or WAC 314-11-035.

1 Enforcement and the Permit Holder wish to enter into a settlement agreement
2 concerning the above-referenced AVN.

3 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

4 Enforcement and the Permit Holder agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Permit Holder enter into this agreement to avoid the time
6 and expense of further litigation. The Permit Holder explicitly waives the right of further
7 administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The
8 Permit Holder hereby voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Permit Holder admits the violation set forth above and referenced in the
12 complaint: that on or about December 12, 2009, the above-named MAST Permit Holder, sold,
13 allowed, and/or permitted an apparently intoxicated person(s) to consume liquor and/or possess
14 liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200 and/or WAC 314-11-035.

15 4. The Permit Holder acknowledges this is the Permit Holder's first violation of this
16 type within a twenty-four month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of one hundred
17 dollars (\$100) or a five (5) day suspension of the MAST permit.

18 5. The Permit Holder agrees to serve a three (3) day suspension of her MAST
19 permit or pay a total monetary penalty of sixty dollars (\$60) for the above-referenced violation.
20 The dates of suspension shall be determined by the Washington State Liquor Control Board, or
21 for a monetary settlement, the amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the
22 final order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to the
23 Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date.

24 6. In the event that the Permit Holder does not make a timely payment, as required
25 by Section II, ¶5, the Permit Holder shall serve a five (5) day suspension of her MAST permit,
26

1 pursuant to WAC 314-17-105; the dates and times of which shall be set by the Washington
2 State Liquor Control Board.


3 7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
4 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
5 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced
6 Complaint.

7 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
8 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


