The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, SUPER SAVER, INC., d/b/a GRAND JUMBO CHINESE RESTAURANT, hereby enter into this Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,658 and Case No. 23,703.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2C0058A, with the following alleged violations of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

On or about February 27, 2010, the above named licensee or employee(s) committed the following violations: 1) allowed a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, to enter and

1 remain in an area of the licensed premise classified by the Liquor Control Board as off-limits
2 to persons under the age of twenty-one (21) contrary to RCW 66.44.310(a); and also 2)
3 allowed or permitted persons to conduct lewd acts contrary to WAC 314-11-050; and also 3)
4 allowed an employed entertainer to consume liquor while working on the licensed premises,
5 contrary to WAC 314.11.015(3)(d).

6 The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division also
7 charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2C0113A,
8 with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and
9 regulations:

10 On or about April 23, 2010, the above named licensee sold, allowed, and/or permitted
11 an apparently intoxicated person(s) to consume liquor and/or possess liquor on the licensed
12 premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200 and/or WAC 314-16-150.

13 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
14 above-referenced AVNs.

15
16 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

17 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

18 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
19 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
20 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violations and AVNs. The Licensee
21 hereby voluntarily withdraws its requests for a hearing in both matters.

22 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
23 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

24 3. The Licensee admits the violations set forth in LCB Case No. 23,658 as
25 referenced in the complaint: that on or about February 27, 2010, the above named licensee or
26 employee(s) committed the following violations: 1) allowed a person under twenty-one (21)

1 years of age, to enter and remain in an area of the licensed premise classified by the Liquor
2 Control Board as off-limits to persons under the age of twenty-one (21) contrary to RCW
3 66.44.310(a); and also 2) allowed or permitted persons to conduct lewd acts contrary to WAC
4 314-11-050; and also 3) allowed an employed entertainer to consume liquor while working on
5 the licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314.11.015(3)(d).

6 4. The Liquor Control Board will dismiss the Complaint in LCB Case No. 23,703
7 with only a warning to the Licensee.

8 5. Licensee agrees to pay a total monetary penalty of nine hundred dollars (\$900)
9 for the violations in LCB Case No. 23,658. It shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date
10 of the Final Order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to
11 the Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date.

12 6. In the event this agreed settlement is accepted by the Liquor Control Board, but
13 that the Licensee fails to make a timely payment, the Licensee shall serve a suspension of its
14 liquor license, pursuant to WAC 314-29-020; the dates and times of which shall be set by the
15 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

16 7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
17 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
18 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above-referenced
19 Complaint.


