

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee SSVK INCORPORATED d/b/a NAVYA LOUNGE INDIAN CUISINE hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,661.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2Z0071F, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

That on or about March 19, 2010, the above-named Licensee, paid by check in the amount of \$269.29 to Liquor Store #101. The transaction was reported as having non-sufficient funds which is considered an extension of credit in violation of RCW 66.28.010(1) and WAC 314-13-020.

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
2 above-referenced AVN.

## 3 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
7 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby  
8 voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Licensee admits the violation set forth above and referenced in the  
12 complaint: that on or about March 19, 2010, the above-named Licensee, paid by check in the  
13 amount of \$269.29 to Liquor Store #101. The transaction was reported as having non-  
14 sufficient funds which is considered an extension of credit in violation of RCW 66.28.010(1)  
15 and WAC 314-13-020.

16 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type  
17 within a twenty four month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of two hundred fifty  
18 dollars (\$250) or a five (5) day suspension of the License # 363137-2E.

19 5. The Licensee acknowledges it has terminated its business operations, and now  
20 stipulates to voluntarily relinquish its liquor license with no further interest remaining in the  
21 license.

22 6. The parties agree that the Licensee's cessation of business operations and  
23 voluntary relinquishment of its liquor license has effectively mooted this enforcement action  
24 and shall act in lieu of the standard penalty.

25 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
26 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


