

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, TRACY ARNOLD MOODY d/b/a STUDIO SEVEN, represented by Tracy A. Moody, Sole Proprietor, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,758.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2E0212A, with the following alleged violations of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

First Charge – That on or about July 31, 2010, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) failed to maintain proper hours of operation in violation of WAC 314-02-015(2), and also;

1 Second Charge – That on or about July 31, 2010 the above-named Licensee, or
2 employee(s) failed to maintain food service requirements in violation of WAC 314-02-035.

3 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
4 above-referenced AVN.

5 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

6 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

7 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
8 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
9 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby
10 voluntarily withdraws its requests for a hearing in this matter.

11 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
12 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

13 3. The Licensee admits to both charges of violations set forth above and
14 referenced in the complaint: that on or about July 31, 2010, the above-named Licensee, or
15 employee(s) failed to maintain proper hours of operation in violation of WAC 314-02-015(2),
16 and also failed to maintain food service requirements in violation of WAC 314-02-035.

17 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type
18 within a twenty four month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of two hundred fifty
19 dollars (\$250) or a five day suspension of the liquor license for each charge.

20 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a total monetary penalty of three hundred dollars
21 (\$300) as a total for both above-referenced violations. This amount shall be paid within
22 thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
23 Payment shall be made to the Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m.
24 on the applicable date.
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
1 6. In the event that the Licensee does not make a timely payment, the Licensee
2 shall serve a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, pursuant to WAC 314-29-020; the
3 dates and times of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

4 7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
5 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
6 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced
7 Complaint.

8 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
9 the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Upon approval, this enforcement action will be
10 dismissed.


