
15 THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board



STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, ROGER SINGH BASRAI d/b/a B'S GARLAND MARKET (Licensee), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 23,765.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board, by Complaint dated November 4, 2010, alleges that on or about September 25, 2010, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1).

2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced Complaint.

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Prior to the issuance of a Complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.

2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced case and Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

3. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced Complaint. Specifically, he admits that on or about September 25, 2010, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1).

4. The Licensee admits that he sold B's Garland Market and no longer owns the business.

5. The parties agree that the violation identified in Paragraph 3 is the Licensee's third violation for sale of liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years and the standard penalty for this violation is a thirty (30) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license. However, the parties agree that the penalty is no longer a viable option, as the licensee has discontinued his business. The parties therefore agree that there will be no assessment of any fees or suspension associated with this violation.

6. This settlement agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms, and shall be effective when signed by all parties and/or their legal representatives.
