

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

2 The allegation set forth in Violation No. 3 in AVN No. 6A0265A is sustained and the
3 Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of five thousand dollars (\$500.00) to:



9 In the event the Licensee cannot make full and timely payment of the monetary penalty
10 of five hundred dollars (\$500), the Licensee shall serve a three (3) day suspension of its liquor
11 license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control
12 Board.

13 Enforcement will convert Violation No. 1 and Violation No. 2 in AVN No. 6A0265A
14 to a written warning. Enforcement shall issue the written warning.

1 (1) On or about September 22, 2010, the above-named Licensee and/or licensed
2 agent received compensation or financial benefit from educational activities or
3 product information presented on the licensed premises of a retailer, contrary to
RCW 66.28.155.

4 (2) On or about September 22, 2010, the above-named Licensee advanced
5 moneys or moneys' worth to a licensed person under an arrangement or received,
6 under an arrangement, an advance of moneys or moneys' worth, contrary to RCW
66.28.010.

7 (3) On or about September 22, 2010, the above-named Licensee allowed an
8 unlicensed agent to canvass for, solicit, receive or take orders for the purchase of
sale of liquor, contrary to RCW 66.24.310.

9 2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement
10 concerning the above-referenced AVN.

11 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

12 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

13 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
14 litigation.

15 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of the
16 above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request
17 for a hearing in this matter.

18 3. The Licensee admits to Violation No. 3 in AVN number 6A0265A that on or
19 about September 22, 2010, the above-named Licensee allowed an unlicensed agent to canvass
20 for, solicit, receive or take orders for the purchase of sale of liquor, contrary to RCW
21 66.24.310.

22 4. In consideration for the Licensee's admission in Paragraph 4, the parties agree
23 that Violation Nos. 1 and 2 in AVN No. 6A0265A will be converted to a written warning.

24 5. The parties agree that this is the Licensee's first violation of this kind within a
25 twenty-four month period, and it has a standard penalty of a three (3) day suspension of the
26

1 Licensee's liquor license or a five hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty, and the Licensee
2 chooses to pay the five-hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty.

3 6. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500) no
4 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent
5 to:

9 7. If the Licensee subsequently fails to make a full and timely payment of the
10 penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 6, then the standard penalty of a three (3) day
11 suspension of the Licensee's Wine Distributor license shall be imposed.

12 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
13 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


14 9. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this

16 10. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
17 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose
18 of making a full and final compromise and settlement of any and all violations arising from the
19 above-referenced AVN.


