17 (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division
18 having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and
19 BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, HOI YUEN LAU d/b/a
20 PANDA WOKS RESTAURANT (Licensee), having appeared *pro se*, and the parties having
21 voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board case
22 number 23,788, arising from Administrative Violation No. 4J0303A, and the Board having
23 considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in this case,
24 now therefore


25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in Administrative Violation
26 No. 4J0303A is sustained and the Licensee shall pay a total monetary penalty of three hundred
dollars (\$300) to:

4 In the event that the Licensee does not make a full and timely payment of the monetary
5 penalty, then the Licensee's liquor license shall be suspended for a period of three (3) days, the

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, HOI YUEN LAU d/b/a PANDA WOKS RESTAURANT (Licensee), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,788 (AVN No. 4J0303A).

I. INTRODUCTION

1. On September 29, 2010, Enforcement issued Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 4J0303A, alleging that on or about October 30, 2010, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, sold/served liquor to an apparently intoxicated person on the licensed premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200.

2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced AVN.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee agree
3 to the following:

4 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
5 litigation.

6 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
7 matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby voluntarily
8 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

9 3. The Licensee admits to the violation in AVN No. 4J0303A that it sold/served
10 liquor to an apparently intoxicated person on the licensed premises on June 12, 2010, contrary
11 to RCW 66.44.200.

12 4. The parties agree that this is the Licensee's first violation of this kind within a
13 twenty-four month period, and it has a standard penalty of a five (5) day suspension of the
14 Licensee's liquor license or a monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500).

15 5. The parties agree that the Licensee will pay a monetary penalty of three hundred
16 dollars (\$300) within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be
17 sent to:

20 6. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the
21 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, the Licensee shall serve a three (3) day
22 suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
23 State Liquor Control Board.


24 7. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
25 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

1 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
2 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


