FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and RUTH AMMONS Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, SUNTAREE THOMPSON d/b/a 7-ELEVEN 2303-17053G (Licensee), and the Board having considered the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the Settlement Agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Board accepts, adopts, and incorporates herein by reference the Stipulated Settlement Agreement between Enforcement and the Licensee in the above-captioned matter and further that the violation set forth and charged in the Administrative Violation Notice of January 14, 2011, issued by the Board in the above-captioned matter is sustained and the Licensee shall pay a total monetary penalty of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for the above-referenced violation. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty in two (2) separate payments of one thousand

dollars (\$1,000.00) each. The first payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 30 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The second payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 60 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board.

In the event that the Licensee fails to make a full and timely payment, the Licensee shall serve a seven (7) day suspension from 10:00 a.m. on May 20, 2011 through 10:00 a.m. May 27, 2011.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

15 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division
16 (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and
17 RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and SUNTAREE THOMPSON (Licensee)
18 d/b/a 7-ELEVEN STORE NO. 2303-17053G, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement
19 agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) No. 23809, arising from Administrative Violation
20 Notice (AVN) No. 4E1014A.

21 **I. INTRODUCTION**

22 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to the
23 Licensee AVN No. 4E1014A, alleging that on or about January 14, 2011, the Licensee, or an
24 employee thereof, sold or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one, contrary to
25 RCW 66.44.270.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee have
3 agreed to resolve AVN No. 4E1014A via settlement. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to
4 the following:

5 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
6 litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily
9 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth in AVN No. 4E1014A.
13 Specifically, on or about January 14, 2011, an employee of the Licensee sold or supplied liquor
14 to a person under the age of twenty-one.

15 5. The Licensee acknowledges that this is the Licensee's second violation of this
16 type within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard penalty of a seven
17 (7) day suspension of the liquor license.

18 6. The Licensee agrees to pay a total monetary penalty of two thousand dollars
19 (\$2,000.00) for the above-referenced Complaint. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty
20 in two (2) separate payments of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) each. The first payment of
21 one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 30 days after the date of the Final
22 Order of the Board. The second payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be made no
23 later than 60 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payments shall be sent to:

1 7. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the
2 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 6, the Licensee's liquor license shall be
3 suspended for a period of (7) days, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
4 State Liquor Control Board.


5 8. The Licensee further agrees that she and all of her employees will participate in
6 a responsible liquor and tobacco sales class provided by Enforcement, no later than 60 days
7 after the date of the Final Order of the Board.

8 9. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
9 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.


