The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the MAST Permit Holder, MICHELLE L. BROWN hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,821.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Permit Holder, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 3F1021Z, and Complaint dated May 16, 2011, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

On or about December 18, 2010, the above named MAST permit holder, allowed or permitted disorderly persons to remain on the licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(b) and RCW 66.20.310(4)(b).

1 Enforcement and the Permit Holder wish to enter into a settlement agreement  
2 concerning the above-referenced AVN and Complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Permit Holder agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Permit Holder enter into this agreement to avoid the time  
6 and expense of further litigation. The Permit Holder explicitly waives the right of further  
7 administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The  
8 Permit Holder hereby voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Permit Holder admits the violation set forth above and referenced in the  
12 Complaint: On or about December 18, 2010, the above named MAST permit holder, allowed  
13 or permitted disorderly persons to remain on the licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-11-  
14 015(3)(b) and RCW 66.20.310(4)(b).

15 4. The Permit Holder acknowledges this is the Permit Holder's first violation of this  
16 type within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of one  
17 hundred dollars (\$100) or a five (5) day suspension of the MAST permit.

18 5. The Permit Holder currently is unemployed and agrees to surrender her MAST  
19 permit for the above-referenced violation. The Permit Holder may reapply for a new MAST  
20 permit and agrees to complete MAST training in conjunction with any new application for a  
21 MAST permit. In consideration of the surrender of the MAST permit, there shall be no  
22 monetary penalty imposed for this violation.

23 6. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this settlement agreement are  
24 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full  
25 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced  
26 Complaint.

1           7.       The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
2 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


