1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Case No.
2 23,832 is approved and adopted in its entirety by this order; that the violation charged in the
3 Complaint dated August 18, 2011, is sustained, and the Licensee shall pay a total monetary
4 penalty of two thousand hundred dollars (\$2000.00) for the above-referenced Complaint in lieu
5 of suspension. The monetary penalty shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the
6 Final Order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. In the event that the Licensee fails
7 to timely pay the monetary penalty the Licensee shall be subject to a seven (7) day suspension
8 of its liquor license, the dates of suspension to be determined by the Washington State Liquor
9 Control Board.

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, TUURI WINES LLC, d/b/a DAMA WINES (Licensee) by and through its attorney JEFF TARADAY, attorney at law, hereby enter into this Stipulated Settlement Agreement for LCB Case No. 23,832.

I. INTRODUCTION

On August 18, 2011, the Washington State Liquor Control Board issued a Complaint alleging that on or about February 26, 2011, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, sold, served, supplied or otherwise provided a person under twenty-one (21) years of age alcohol, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 (1) and WAC 314-11-020(1).

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Enforcement and the Licensee have agreed to enter into the following Stipulated Settlement Agreement concerning the above-referenced case. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
2 expense of further litigation.

3 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
4 matters related to the above-referenced case. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily
5 withdraws its request for a hearing on this matter.

6 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
7 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

8 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the Complaint of August 18,
9 2011 in the above captioned case. Specifically, that on or about February 26, 2011, the above-
10 named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, sold, served, supplied or otherwise provided a person
11 under twenty-one (21) years of age alcohol, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 (1) and WAC 314-11-
12 020(1).

13 5. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's second violation of this type
14 within a twenty-four (24) month period; which carries a standard penalty of a seven (7) day
15 suspension of the liquor license.

16 6. The Licensee agrees to pay a total monetary penalty of two thousand dollars
17 (\$2000.00) for the above-referenced Complaint in lieu of suspension of the liquor license. No
18 suspension of the liquor license will be imposed if the monetary penalty is paid to the
19 Washington State Liquor Control Board, in a timely fashion, as set forth in Part II, ¶6. The
20 monetary penalty of two thousand dollars (\$2000.00) shall be paid within thirty (30) days of
21 the date of the Final Order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be
22 made to the Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable

1 7. In the event that the Licensee fails to timely pay the monetary penalty, as set out
2 in Part II, ¶6, the Licensee shall be subject to a seven (7) day suspension of its liquor license,
3 the dates of suspension to be determined by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

4 8. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
5 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
6 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above-referenced
7 Complaint.

8 9. The parties recognize that this Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by
9 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.




