
1 2011 is sustained and the Licensee shall pay a total monetary penalty of three hundred dollars

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, PARADISE BILLIARDS, LLC d/b/a UNCLE JACK'S BILLIARDS & LOUNGE, through its representative, RENATO CAMANTIGUE, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 23,834.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, with an Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 3H1097A and Complaint dated May 16, 2011, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

1 On or about April 8, 2011, the above named licensee sold, allowed, and/or permitted an  
2 apparently intoxicated person(s) to consume liquor and/or possess liquor on the licensed  
3 premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200 and/or WAC 314-16-150.

4 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
5 above-referenced AVN.

6 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

7 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

8 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
9 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
10 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation. The Licensee hereby  
11 voluntarily withdraws its requests for a hearing in this matter.

12 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
13 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

14 3. The Licensee admits the violation set forth above and referenced in the  
15 Complaint: that on or about April 8, 2011, the above named licensee sold, allowed, and/or  
16 permitted an apparently intoxicated person(s) to consume liquor and/or possess liquor on the  
17 licensed premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200 and/or WAC 314-16-150.

18 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type  
19 within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard penalty of a five (5) day  
20 suspension of the liquor license, or five hundred dollars (\$500) monetary penalty.

21 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a three hundred dollar (\$300) monetary penalty for  
22 the above-referenced violation. The amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of  
23 the final order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to the  
24 Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date.


6. In the event that the Licensee does not make a timely payment, as required by Section II, ¶5, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day suspension, pursuant to WAC 314-17-105; the dates and times of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced Complaint.

8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


