STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, PAPA'S PUB, LLC d/b/a PAPA'S PUB, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No.'s 23,848; 23,881; 23,914; 23,915; 23,916.

I. INTRODUCTION

On May 5, 2011, Enforcement served the above-identified Licensee with an Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2L1119A alleging that the Licensee sold or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty one (21) years on or about April 29, 2011. [Associated LCB Case No. 23,848].

On July 20, 2011, Enforcement served the above-identified Licensee with an Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2L1196A alleging that the Licensee sold or served

1 liquor to a person under the age of twenty one (21) years on or about July 15, 2011.
2 [Associated LCB Case No. 23,881].

3 On October 28, 2011, Enforcement served the above-identified Licensee with an
4 Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2L1300A alleging that the Licensee sold or served
5 liquor to an apparently intoxicated person on or about July 28, 2011. [Associated LCB Case
6 No. 23,914].

7 On October 28, 2011, Enforcement served the above-identified Licensee with an
8 Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2L1300B alleging that the Licensee sold or served
9 liquor to an apparently intoxicated person on or about August 3, 2011. [Associated LCB Case
10 No. 23,915].

11 On October 25, 2011, Enforcement served the above-identified Licensee with an
12 Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2L1273A alleging that the Licensee sold or served
13 liquor to a person under the age of twenty one (21) years on or about September 30, 2011.
14 [Associated LCB Case No. 23,916].

15 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
16 above-referenced AVN's and associated LCB Case No.'s.

17 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

18 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

19 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
20 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
21 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violations for LCB Case No.'s 23,848;
22 23,881; 23,914; 23,915; 23,916 and their associated AVNs. The Licensee hereby voluntarily
23 withdraws his request for a hearing in each LCB case number listed in this paragraph.

24 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
25 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

1 3. The Licensee stipulates to the above-referenced violations for LCB Case No.'s
 2 23,848; 23,881; 23,914; 23,915; 23,916 and their associated AVNs.

3 4. The Licensee acknowledges it has terminated its business operations, and now
 4 stipulates to voluntarily relinquish its liquor license with no further interest remaining in the
 5 license.

6 5. The parties agree that the Licensee's cessation of business operations and
 7 voluntary relinquishment of its liquor license has effectively mooted these enforcement actions
 8 in all LCB Case No.'s 23,848; 23,881; 23,914; 23,915; 23,916. In lieu for stipulating to the
 9 alleged violations and for voluntarily relinquishing its liquor license there shall be no monetary
 10 penalty imposed or due.

11 6. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
 12 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


