THIS MATTER comes before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) for entry of an Order Amending the Final Order of the Board Approving the Stipulated Settlement Agreement.

On August 18, 2011, the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and NORMAN FORD d/b/a CASEY'S RESTAURANT (Permit Holder), sought entry of a Final Order of the Board Approving the Stipulated Settlement Agreement. The Board, after having considered the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, entered a Final Order requiring the Permit Holder to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) within 30 days of the date of the


1 Final Order. A copy of the Final Order is attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated  
2 herein by reference.

3 The Permit Holder's Temporary Permit expired on August 16, 2011, and was not  
4 re-issued. Thereafter, the Permit Holder amended its application type to a nightclub license.  
5 The application is still pending decision. The Permit Holder reports that, in the interim, his  
6 business has not been in operation, which has resulted in financial hardship. The Permit  
7 Holder and Enforcement agree that a 60-day extension of the time within which to pay the  
8 monetary penalty is appropriate under the circumstances. Now, therefore:

9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Final Order of the Board Approving the Stipulated  
10 Settlement Agreement, entered by the Board on August 18, 2011, is amended as follows: the  
11 Permit Holder shall pay a monetary penalty of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) on or  
12 before November 16, 2011. All other provisions of the Final Order remain in full force and  
13 effect.


