THIS MATTER having come before The Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and STEPHANIE U. HAPPOLD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, TROPHIES BAR & EATERY, LLC d/b/a TROPHIES BAR AND EATERY a/k/a NATIONS PUB: LIQ (Licensee) by and through its registered agent and attorney of record, DAVID H. GEHRKE, and its governing person, DARRON CAGE, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Case Numbers 23,870; 23,920; 23,941; 24,063; and 24,089, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaints issued in LCB Nos. 23,870; 23,920; 23,941; 24,063; and the AVN issued in 24,089 are sustained.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Licensee's closure of the business involving the liquor license and the voluntarily relinquishing of the liquor license will act in lieu of the standard penalties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that the Licensee fails to relinquish its liquor license by June 30, 2012, for any reason, the Licensee shall serve a seventy-nine (79) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and STEPHANIE U. HAPPOLD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, TROPHIES BAR & EATERY, LLC d/b/a TROPHIES BAR AND EATERY a/k/a NATIONS PUB: LIQ (Licensee) by and through its registered agent and attorney of record, DAVID H. GEHRKE, and its governing person, DARRON CAGE, hereby enter into this stipulation and settlement agreement for LCB Case Nos. 23,870; 23,920; 23,941; 24,063; and 24,089.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The Board issued a complaint in LCB No. 23,870 alleging that on or about June 16, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, sold, allowed, and/or permitted

1 an apparently intoxicated person(s) to consume liquor and/or possess liquor on the licensed  
2 premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200(1) and WAC 314-11-035.

3 2. The Board issued a complaint in LCB No. 23,920 alleging that on or about  
4 October 12, 2011, an employee of the Licensee was drinking alcohol while on duty, contrary to  
5 WAC 314-11-015(3)(d).

6 3. The Board issued a complaint in LCB No. 23,941 alleging that on or about  
7 December 1, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, supplied and/or sold  
8 liquor to an apparently intoxicated person(s), and/or allowed and/or permitted an apparently  
9 intoxicated person(s) to consume and/or possess liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to  
10 WAC 314-16-150.

11 4. The Board issued a complaint in LCB No. 24,063 alleging that on or about  
12 December 10, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, engaged in or  
13 permitted any employee or other person to engage in, conduct on the licensed premises which  
14 is prohibited by any portion of Titles 9, 9A, or 69 RCW, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(e).

15 5. Enforcement issued an AVN for LCB No. 24,089 alleging that on or about  
16 April 14, 2012, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, allowed an apparently  
17 intoxicated person to possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises, contrary  
18 WAC 314-16-150.

19 6. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement  
20 concerning the above-referenced Complaints and AVNs.

21 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

22 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

23 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further  
24 litigation.

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1           2.     The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all  
2 matters related to the above-referenced cases and AVNs. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby  
3 voluntarily withdraws its requests for hearings in these matters.

4           3.     The Licensee disputes the truth of the allegations contained in LCB Nos.  
5 23,870; 23,920; 23,941; 24,063; and 24,089. However, in order to take advantage of  
6 Enforcement's offer of settlement, the Licensee agrees that, were these matters to proceed to  
7 hearing, there is a substantial likelihood that Enforcement would be able to prove the  
8 allegations contained in LCB Nos. 23,870; 23,920; 23,941; 24,063; and 24,089, to wit:

- 9           (a)    Licensee, or employee thereof, allowed an apparently intoxicated person to  
10 possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises on June 16, 2011, as  
11 detailed in AVN No. 2M1167A (LCB No. 23,870); and
- 12           (b)    Licensee's employee was drinking alcohol while on duty on October 12, 2011,  
13 as detailed in AVN No. 2M1285A (LCB No. 23,920); and
- 14           (c)    Licensee, or employee thereof, allowed an apparently intoxicated person to  
15 possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises on December 1, 2011,  
16 as detailed in AVN No. 2M1335E (LCB No. 23,941); and
- 17           (d)    Licensee's employee engaged in conduct on the licensed premises which is  
18 prohibited by any portion of Titles 9, 9A, or 69 RCW, as detailed in AVN No.  
19 2M1343B (LCB No. 24, 063); and
- 20           (e)    Licensee, or employee thereof, allowed an apparently intoxicated person to  
21 possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises on April 14, 2012, as  
22 detailed in AVN No. 2M2105A (LCB No. 24, 089).

23 The parties agree that the Washington State Liquor Control Board will consider that the  
24 violations set forth in LCB Nos. 23,870; 23,920; 23,941; 24,063; and 24,089, and specified in  
25 this paragraph, have been sustained and will become part of the Licensee's violation record.

26           4.     The parties also agree that:

- 1 (a) The violation in LCB No. 23,870 is the first violation of its kind and it carries  
2 with it a five (5) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license or a five  
3 hundred dollars (\$500) monetary penalty in lieu of the suspension; and
- 4 (b) The violation in LCB No. 23,920 is the second violation of its kind and the  
5 penalty is a seven (7) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license with no  
6 option of a monetary penalty; and
- 7 (c) The violation in LCB No. 23,941 is a second violation on its kind and the  
8 penalty is a seven (7) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license with no  
9 option of a monetary penalty; and
- 10 (d) The violation in LCB No. 24,063 is a third violation of its kind and it carries  
11 with it a thirty (30) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license with no  
12 option of a monetary penalty; and
- 13 (e) The violation in LCB No. 24,089 is a third violation of its kind and it carries  
14 with it a thirty (30) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license with no  
15 option of a monetary penalty.

16 5. Licensee admits that after requesting hearings for the above-referenced matters,  
17 it closed its business and voluntarily relinquished its liquor license on June 30, 2012. After  
18 June 30, 2012, Licensee had no interest in the license at issue.

19 6. The parties agree that the Licensee's closure of the business involving the liquor  
20 license and the voluntarily relinquishing of the liquor license will act in lieu of the standard  
21 penalties listed in Section II.4.


22 7. The Licensee agrees that if, for any reason, it fails to relinquish its liquor  
23 license, the total amount of the standard liquor license suspension penalties listed for above-  
24 mentioned violations in Section II.4 shall be imposed, equaling seventy-nine (79) days. The  
25 dates and time of the suspension penalties shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control  
26 Board and shall run consecutively.

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8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

9. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full and final compromise and settlement of any and all violations arising from the above-referenced AVNs and Complaints.




