THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, MY SUZIE, INC. d/b/a SEAFARERS SPORTS BAR & GRILL, represented by Richard A. Jones, and the Board having considered the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the Settlement Agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Board accepts, adopts, and incorporates herein by reference the Stipulated Settlement Agreement between Enforcement and the Licensee in the above-captioned matter and further that the violation set forth in the Complaint dated August 31, 2011 is sustained and the Licensee shall pay a total monetary penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for the above-referenced violation. The Licensee shall pay the


1 monetary penalty within thirty (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. All

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, MY SUZIE, INC. d/b/a SEAFARERS SPORTS BAR & GRILL represented by RICHARD A. JONES, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,874.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensees, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1S1189A, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

On or about July 8, 2011, the above-named Licensee and/or an employee thereof, did consume liquor while working on the licensed premises contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(d).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced AVN.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby
8 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Licensee admits the violation set forth above and referenced in the
12 Complaint: on or about July 8, 2011, the above-named Licensee and/or an employee thereof,
13 did consume liquor while working on the licensed premises contrary to WAC 314-11-
14 015(3)(d).

15 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type
16 within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard penalty of a five (5) day
17 suspension of the liquor license, or a five hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty.

18 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a two hundred fifty dollar (\$250) monetary penalty
19 for the above-referenced violation. The amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date
20 of the final order issued by the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be
21 made to the Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable
22 date.


23 6. In the event that the Licensee does not make a timely payment, as required by
24 Section II, ¶5, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day suspension, pursuant to WAC 314-17-
25 105; the dates and times of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

1 7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
2 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
3 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced
4 Complaint.


5 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by




