
THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, B2 HOLDINGS, LLC., d/b/a B2C WINE (Licensee), by and through its representative, PAETON RICHARD BANGART, member manager, and the Board having considered the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

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1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Case No.
2 23,877 is approved and adopted in its entirety by this order; that two of the violations charged
3 in the Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 6C1215A, failure to pay for delivered wine
4 and/or beer prior to or at the time of delivery, in violation of WAC 314-13-015; and selling,
5 supplying or otherwise providing alcohol for on premise consumption in violation of WAC
6 314-02-105, are sustained, and the Licensee shall be subject to a combined four (4) day
7 suspension of their liquor license for the above-referenced AVN to take place **from 12:00 p.m.**
8 **Friday, March 30, 2012 to 12:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 3, 2012.** In the event that the
9 Licensee operates under its liquor license during its suspension, the Licensee shall be subject to
10 a further combined eight (8) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates of suspension to be
11 determined by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, B2 Holdings, LLC d/b/a B2C Wine (Licensee) represented by PAETON RICHARD BANGART, Member, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,877.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 6C1215A, with the following three alleged violations of the Washington State Liquor Act:

1. That between February 26, 2011 and August 31, 2011, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, received wine and/or beer from an industry member and failed to pay for the delivered wine and/or beer prior to or at the time of delivery, in violation of WAC 314-13-015.

1 5. The Licensee acknowledges that:
2 a. This is the Licensee's first violation of WAC 314-13-015 within a
3 twenty-four (24) month period; which carries a standard penalty of a three (3) day suspension of
4 the Licensee's liquor license or a monetary penalty of five-hundred dollars (\$500).
5 b. This is the Licensee's first violation of WAC 314-02-105 within a
6 twenty-four (24) month period; which carries a standard penalty of a three (5) day suspension of
7 the Licensee's liquor license or a monetary penalty of one thousand five hundred dollars
8 (\$1,500).
9 6. The Licensee agrees to a combined penalty of a four (4) day suspension of their
10 liquor license. The suspension is to take place **from 12:00 p.m. Friday, March 30, 2012 to**
11 **12:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 3, 2012.**
12 7. In the event that the Licensee operates under its liquor license during its
13 suspension, as set out in Part II, ¶5, the Licensee shall be subject to a further combined eight
14 (8) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates of suspension to be determined by the
15 Washington State Liquor Control Board.
16 8. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
17 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
18 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above-referenced
19 AVN.
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9. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


