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1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Case No.

4 subject to a two (2) day suspension of their liquor license for the above-referenced AVN to
5 take place **from 12:00 p.m. Thursday, April 5, 2012 to 12:00 p.m. Saturday, April 7, 2012.**
6 In the event that the Licensee operates under its liquor license during its suspension, the
7 Licensee shall be subject to a further (3) day suspension of its license, the dates of suspension
8 to be determined by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, B2 Holdings, LLC d/b/a B2C Wine (Licensee) represented by PAETON RICHARD BANGART, Member, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,878.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 6C1215B, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

That on or before July 22, 2011, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, removed wine produced by a third party from the Licensee's bonded warehouse and delivered it to the Licensee's separate retail establishment, to sell at retail, in violation of WAC 314-24-220(5)-(6).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced AVN.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby
8 voluntarily withdraws its requests for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Licensee stipulates to the following violation of the Washington State
12 Liquor Act: that on or about July 22, 2011 Licensee or employee(s) thereof, removed wine
13 produced by a third party from the Licensee's bonded warehouse and delivered it to the
14 Licensee's separate retail establishment, to sell at retail, in violation of WAC 314-24-220(5)-
15 (6).

16 4. The Licensee acknowledges that this is the Licensee's first violation of this type
17 within a twenty-four (24) month period; which carries a standard penalty of a three (3) day
18 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license or a monetary penalty of five-hundred dollars
19 (\$500).

20 5. The Licensee agrees to a penalty of a two (2) day suspension of their bonded
21 wine warehouse license. The suspension is to take place **from 12:00 p.m. Thursday, April 5,**
22 **2012 to 12:00 p.m. Saturday, April 7, 2012.**

23 6. In the event that the Licensee operates under its bonded wine warehouse license
24 during its suspension, as set out in Part II, ¶5, the Licensee shall be subject to a further (3) day
25 suspension of its license, the dates of suspension to be determined by the Washington State
26 Liquor Control Board.

1 7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
2 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
3 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above-referenced
4 AVN.

5 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
6 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


