18 (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and
19 STEPHANIE U. HAPPOLD, Assistant Attorney General, and TROPHIES BAR & EATERY,
20 LLC d/b/a TROPHIES BAR & EATERY (Licensee) of Renton, Washington, through its
21 attorney, DAVID GEHRKE, and its representative, ART CAGE, and the Board having
22 considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum
23 recommending acceptance of the settlement agreement, and the Board having had the
24 opportunity to review the file materials maintained in these cases, now therefore:

25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Case Nos.
26 23,886 and 23,904 is approved and adopted in its entirety; the AVN Nos. 2M1196A &
2M1269B in the above-captioned cases are sustained; and the Licensee shall pay a monetary

1 penalty of two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$2,800) to be paid in two separate payments of
2 one thousand four hundred dollars (\$1,400). The first payment shall be due thirty (30) days
3 from the date of this final order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. The second
4 payment shall be due sixty (60) days from the date of this final order of the Washington State
5 Liquor Control Board. The payments shall be sent to:

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and STEPHANIE U. HAPPOLD, Assistant Attorney General, and TROPHIES BAR & EATERY, LLC d/b/a TROPHIES BAR & EATERY (Licensee) of Renton, Washington, through its attorney, DAVID GEHRKE, and its representative, ART CAGE, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement (Agreement) for Liquor Control Board Case Nos. 23,886 & 23,904.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. On July 29, 2011, the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division issued an Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2M1196A, charging the Licensee with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

1 That on or about July 15, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof,
2 gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to
3 RCW 66.44.270 and RCW 66.44.310.

4 2. On September 29, 2011, the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education
5 and Enforcement Division issued an Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2M1269B,
6 charging the Licensee with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

7 That on or about September 26, 2011, the above-named Licensee's premises had
8 inadequate lighting contrary to WAC 314-11-055.

9 3. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into an Agreement concerning the
10 above-referenced AVNs.

11 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

12 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

13 1. The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
14 litigation.

15 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
16 matters related to the above-referenced violations. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
17 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in these matters.

18 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
19 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms, and shall be effective
20 when signed by all parties and/or their legal representatives.

21 4. The Licensee admits to the violation that on July 15, 2011, the above-named
22 Licensee, or an employee thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person under the age
23 of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and RCW 66.44.310. The parties agree that
24 this violation would be the second violation pursuant to WAC 314-29-020 within a twenty-four
25 (24) month period, which carries a standard penalty of a seven (7) days suspension of the liquor
26 license.

1. 5. The Licensee admits to the violation that on September 26, 2011, the above-
2 named Licensee's premises had inadequate lighting contrary to WAC 314-11-055. The parties
3 agree that this violation would be the second violation pursuant to WAC 314-29-025 within a
4 twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard penalty of a five hundred dollars (\$500)
5 monetary fine or a five (5) days suspension of the liquor license.

6 6. The parties agree that the July 15, 2011 AVN No. 2M1196A penalty will be
7 converted to a two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) monetary penalty with no suspension.

8 7. The parties agree that the September 26, 2011 AVN No. 2M1269A penalty will
9 be converted to a three hundred dollars (\$300) monetary penalty with no suspension.

10 8. In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, the Licensee agrees to pay
11 a total of two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$2,800) for the above-referenced violations. The
12 Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty in two (2) separate payments. The first payment of
13 one thousand four hundred dollars (\$1,400) shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of
14 the final order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. The second payment of one
15 thousand four hundred dollars (\$1,400) shall be paid within sixty (60) days of the date of the
16 final order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payments shall be made to the
17 Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date.

22 9. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payments of the
23 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 8, the Licensee shall serve a twelve (12)
24 day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and times of which shall be set by the
25 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

26 10. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

1 11. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
2 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
3 and final compromise and settlement of any and all violations arising from the above-
4 referenced AVNs.


