THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, DINA MAYA INC, d/b/a 7-ELEVEN 2307-25525D, through its representative, INAD KHRIES, and the Board having considered the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Enforcement’s memorandum recommending acceptance of the Settlement Agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Board accepts, adopts, and incorporates herein by reference the Stipulated Settlement Agreement between Enforcement and the Licensee in the above-captioned matter and further that the violation set forth in the Complaint dated November 16, 2011 is sustained and the Licensee shall serve a four-day suspension of the

1 liquor license for the above-referenced violation. The suspension shall start Thursday, April
2 26, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. through and ending on Monday, April 30, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.

3 The Licensee shall have all employees' complete training on the sale of liquor, to be
4 provided at no cost by the Liquor Control Board within thirty (30) days after entry of this Final
5 Order of the Board. The Licensee shall have all future employees complete training on the sale
6 of liquor, to be provided at no cost by the Liquor Control Board within thirty (30) days of each
7 employee's initial hire date. The Licensee shall install equipment or software with the existing
8 cash register system that will require the entry of the date of birth for every liquor/tobacco sale
9 within thirty (30) days after entry of this Final Order of the Board.

10 In the event the Licensee fails to fully and timely satisfy the penalties and conditions
11 set forth in this order, then the standard penalty of a seven (7) day suspension shall be imposed,
12 the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, DINA MAYA INC, d/b/a 7-ELEVEN 2307-25525D, through its representative, INAD KHRIES, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 23,896.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee in a Complaint dated November 16, 2011, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

On or about August 12, 2011 the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, gave, sold, and/or supplied liquor to a person(s) under the age of twenty-one (21), in violation of RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced Complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation. The Licensee hereby
8 voluntarily withdraws its requests for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth above and referenced in the
12 Complaint: On or about August 12, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof,
13 gave, sold, and/or supplied liquor to a person(s) under the age of twenty-one (21), in violation
14 of RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1).

15 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's second violation of this type
16 within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard penalty of a seven (7) day
17 suspension of the liquor license pursuant to WAC 314-29-020.

18 5. The Licensee agrees to serve a four (4) day suspension of the liquor license for
19 the above-referenced violation. The suspension shall start Thursday, April 26, 2012 at
20 10:00 a.m. through and ending on Monday, April 30, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.

21 6. The Licensee agrees to have all employees' complete training on the sale of
22 liquor, to be provided at no cost by the Liquor Control Board within thirty (30) days after entry
23 of the Final Order of the Board. The Licensee agrees to have all future employees complete
24 training on the sale of liquor, to be provided at no cost by the Liquor Control Board within
25 thirty (30) days of each employee's initial hire date. The Licensee also agrees to install
26 equipment or software with the existing cash register system that will require the entry of the

1 date of birth for every tobacco sale (within thirty (30) days after entry of the Final Order of the
2 Board).


3 7. In the event that the Licensee does not fully and timely satisfy the penalties and
4 conditions set forth in Section II, Paragraph 5 & 6, then the standard penalty shall be imposed
5 as referenced under Section II, Paragraph 4.

6 8. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
7 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
8 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced
9 Complaint.

10 9. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
11 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


