THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and MARISA E. BROGGEL, Assistant Attorney General, and EFG, LLC d/b/a NORTHERN PACIFIC COFFEE COMPANY (Licensee) represented by and through EDWARD CEDRAS, member of EFG, LLC, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1T1256A, Case No. 23,906, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now, therefore:


1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 1T1256A, to wit:
2 Licensee or employee thereof supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, is
3 sustained. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within thirty (30) days of the date of this order,
4 Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) to:

10 In the event the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the monetary

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and MARISA E. BROGGEL, Assistant Attorney General, and EFG, LLC d/b/a NORTHERN PACIFIC COFFEE COMPANY (Licensee), represented by and through EDWARD CEDRAS, member of EFG, LLC, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Case No. 23,906, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1T1256A.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement and Education Division issued AVN No. 1T1256A to the Licensee, alleging that on or around September 13, 2011, the Licensee or employee(s) thereof, gave, sold or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, in violation of RCW 66.44.270(1).

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to scheduling an administrative hearing in this matter, Enforcement and the
3 Licensee have agreed to enter into the following Stipulated Settlement Agreement (Agreement)
4 concerning the above-referenced AVN. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right to further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced AVN No. 1T1256A. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
9 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced AVN No.
13 1T1256A. Specifically, Licensee admits that on or around September 13, 2011, the above-
14 named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21)
15 years of age, in violation of RCW 66.44.270(1).

16 5. The Licensee admits that the above-referenced violation is the Licensee's first
17 violation of this type within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the standard penalty is
18 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license for five (5) days or a monetary penalty of five
19 hundred dollars (\$500).

20 6. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300)
21 for the above-referenced violation. The Licensee agrees to pay this penalty in full within thirty
22 (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board, no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable
23 date. Payment shall be sent to:

7. In the event that the Licensee fails to make a full or timely payment of the monetary penalty, as set out and required by Section II, Paragraph 6, the Licensee shall be subject to a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates of suspension to be determined by the Board.

8. The parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the Board.


