FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above entitled matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Liquor Control Board issued a Statement of Intent to Revoke Liquor License on February 9, 2012 based on the Licensee's conviction of eight gross misdemeanors in Seattle Municipal Court, which resulted in the accumulation of 40 criminal record points under the provisions of WAC 314-07-040(1).
2. The Licensee submitted a timely request for a hearing.
3. An administrative hearing was scheduled for October 3, 2012 in Tacoma, Washington, before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Lisa Dublin.
4. On September 27, 2012, Licensee's attorney of record, Billie Morelli, send an email to Assistant Attorney General Stephanie Happold, attorney for record for Licensing, stating that Mr. Moody no longer required the license at issue and that Mr. Moody and Ms Morelli would not be in attendance at the October 3, 2012 hearing and that the parties were going to submit an Order of Default for LCB Case. No. 23,909.
5. On September 27, 2012, AAG Happold forwarded the email on to ALJ Dublin, stating the

October 3, 2012 hearing was not needed.


6. On October 11, 2012 , ALJ Lisa N. Dublin entered her Initial Order of Default, ordering that the Licensee is in Default; that those facts and conclusions contained in Licensing's Statement of Intent to Revoke Liquor License for LCB No. 23,909 are now considered to be established; and the Licensing's Statement of Intent to Revoke Liquor License in this matter is Sustained; and that the liquor license shall be revoked.

7. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises; NOW THEREFORE; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case 23,909 is adopted. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Licensing's Statement of Intent to Revoke Liquor License in this matter is SUSTAINED; and that the liquor license of Tracy Arnold Moody d/b/a Studio Seven, License Number 085082, is hereby REVOKED.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties

of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.




