2 the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a), is sustained.



I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement and Education Division (Enforcement) charged the licensee with the following violation of Title 66 RCW and/or Title 314 WAC by its complaint dated January 11, 2012:

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced Complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right to further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced violation. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
9 voluntarily withdraws its request for a formal administrative hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth in the Complaint.
13 Specifically, the Licensee admits that or around September 10, 2011, the Licensee or
14 employee(s) thereof was disorderly or apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises, in
15 violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

16 5. The Licensee admits that this is the Licensee's first violation of this type within
17 a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the standard penalty is a monetary penalty of five
18 hundred dollars (\$500) or suspension of the Licensee's liquor license for five (5) days.

19 6. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300)
20 within thirty (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board, no later than 4:00 p.m. on
21 the applicable date, for the violation stipulated to in Section II, Paragraph 4. Payment shall be

5 8. The parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the Board.




