
1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaint for Case Number 23,911 is sustained

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and STEPHANIE U. HAPPOLD, Assistant Attorney General, and FRANK WARREN AND CHERI LYNN SCHNARRS d/b/a FRANKIE'S SPORTS BAR GRILL & LOUNGE (Licensee) of Olympia, Washington, through its representative, FRANK WARREN SCHNARRS, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement (Agreement) for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,911.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board issued a Complaint against the Licensee, alleging that on or about September 15, 2011, the above named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, committed the following violations contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3):

- 1 a. Was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-11-
- 2 015(3)(a); and/or
- 3 b. Consumed liquor of any kind while working on the licensed premises, contrary
- 4 to WAC 314-11-015(3)(d); and/or
- 5 c. Engaged in, or permitted any employee or other person to engage in, conduct on
- 6 the licensed premises prohibited by any portion of Titles 9, 9A, or 69 RCW,
- 7 contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(e).

8 2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into an Agreement concerning the
 9 above-referenced Complaint.

10 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

11 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

12 1. The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
 13 litigation.

14 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
 15 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
 16 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

17 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
 18 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms, and shall be effective
 19 when signed by all parties and/or their legal representatives.

20 4. The Licensee admits to the violation in the above-referenced AVN, that is, that
 21 on or about September 15, 2011, the above named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof,
 22 committed the following violations contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3):

- 23 a. Was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises; and
- 24 b. Consumed liquor of any kind while working on the licensed premises; and
- 25 c. Engaged in, or permitted any employee or other person to engage in, conduct on
- 26 the licensed premises prohibited by any portion of Titles 9, 9A, or 69 RCW.




