BROGGEL, Assistant Attorney General, and RAY & SONS, INC. d/b/a WILD WILLIE'S (Licensee), represented by and through its attorney, STEVEN SOWARDS, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1J1336B, Case No. 23,926, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now, therefore:

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 1J1336B, to wit:
2 Licensee or employee thereof gave, sold, and/or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under
3 twenty-one (21) years of age, is sustained.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee's cessation of business operations and
5 voluntarily relinquishing of its liquor license shall act in lieu of the standard penalty for this
6 violation, which is a seven- (7) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and MARISA E. BROGGEL, Assistant Attorney General, and RAY & SONS, INC. d/b/a WILD WILLIE'S (Licensee), represented by and through its attorney, STEVEN SOWARDS, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Case No. 23,926, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1J1336B.

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I. INTRODUCTION

On or around December 6, 2011, Enforcement issued to the Licensee AVN No. 1J1336B, alleging that on or around December 2, 2011, the Licensee or an employee thereof sold liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21). The Licensee requested an administrative hearing. The Board subsequently charged the Licensee with the following violation of Title 66 RCW and/or Title 314 WAC by its complaint dated March 27, 2012:

That on or around December 2, 2011, the Licensee or employee(s) thereof gave, sold or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, in violation of RCW 66.44.270(1).

Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced Complaint.

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.
2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right to further administrative review of all matters related to AVN No. 1J1336B. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.
3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

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1 4. The Licensee stipulates to the violation as set forth in the Board's complaint
2 dated March 27, 2012.¹

3 5. The Licensee admits that the above-referenced violation is the Licensee's
4 second violation of this type within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the standard
5 penalty is suspension of the Licensee's liquor license for seven (7) days.
6

7 6. The parties agree that the Licensee ceased business operations on or around
8 October 1, 2012, and closed the premise associated with Liquor License No. 368184 ("Wild
9 Willies"). The parties further agree that as of the date of this Settlement Agreement, the
10 Licensee has voluntarily relinquished Liquor License No. 368184.

11 7. The parties agree that the Licensee's cessation of business operations and
12 voluntary surrender of its liquor license has effectively mooted AVN No. 1J1336B and related
13 administrative proceedings, and that this license surrender shall act in lieu of the standard
14 penalty.

16 8. The parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the Board.

17 9. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Agreement are completely
18 read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full and final
19 compromise and settlement of any and all violations arising from the above-referenced AVN.


