THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and MARISA E. BROGGEL, Assistant Attorney General, and ON OUR OWN, LLC d/b/a DOUBLE D'S BAR & GRILL (Licensee), represented by and through LISA M. DECKER, Member, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2L1333A, Case No. 23,937, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 2L1333A, to wit: that on or about November 3, 2011, the Licensee was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a), is sustained.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of three  
2 hundred dollars (\$300). The Licensee agrees to pay this amount within thirty (30) days of the  
3 date of the Final Order of the Board, no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date. Payments



10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee and all of its employees will participate  
11 in a Responsible Liquor Sales training class with its assigned Liquor Enforcement Officer(s)

14 penalty, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and  
15 time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and MARISA E. BROGGEL, Assistant Attorney General, and ON OUR OWN, LLC d/b/a DOUBLE D'S BAR & GRILL (Licensee), represented by and through LISA M. DECKER, Member, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Case No. 23,937, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2L1333A.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement and Education Division issued AVN No. 2L1333A to the Licensee, alleging that on or around November 3, 2011, the Licensee was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to scheduling an administrative hearing in this matter, Enforcement and the  
3 Licensee have agreed to enter into the following Stipulated Settlement Agreement  
4 (Agreement) concerning the above-referenced AVN. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to  
5 the following:

6 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and  
7 expense of further litigation.

8 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right to further administrative review of all  
9 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily  
10 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

11 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
12 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

13 4. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth in the above-referenced AVN.  
14 Specifically, the Licensee admits that or around November 3, 2011, the Licensee was  
15 apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises, in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

16 5. The Licensee admits that the violation to which it stipulates is the Licensee's  
17 first violation of this type within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the standard  
18 penalty is a monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500) or suspension of the Licensee's  
19 liquor license for five (5) days.

20 6. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300)  
21 within thirty (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board, no later than 4:00 p.m. on  
22 the applicable date, for the violation stipulated to in Section II, Paragraph 4. Payment shall be


1 7. In the event that the Licensee fails to make the full payment of the monetary  
2 penalty on time, as set out and required by Section II, Paragraph 6, the Licensee shall be  
3 subject to a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates of suspension to be  
4 determined by the Board.

5 8. The Licensee further agrees that within thirty (30) days of the date of the Final  
6 Order of the Board, the Licensee and all its employees will participate in a Responsible  
7 Liquor Sales training class through Enforcement. The Licensee is responsible for  
8 coordinating the date, time and location of the training class through its assigned Liquor  
9 Enforcement Officer.

10 9. The parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the Board.

11 10. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Agreement are  
12 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full  
13 and final compromise and settlement of any and all violations arising from the above-  
14 referenced AVN.


