26 hundred dollars (\$600) for the above-referenced violations. The Licensee shall pay the


1 monetary penalty within thirty (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. All

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board), Enforcement and Education Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and STACEY LYNNAE BRENNAN d/b/a PARADISE (Licensee) of Chehalis, Washington, through its governing member, STACEY BRENNAN, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 24,102.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1E2150B, and the Board filed a complaint with the following alleged violations of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

On or about May 29, 2012, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, refused to allow an inspection and/or obstructed a law enforcement officer in violation of

1 RCW 66.28.090; 66.44.370; and WAC 314-11-090. Additionally the Licensee, or employee(s)  
2 thereof, were intoxicated on the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

3 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
4 above-referenced AVN.

## 5 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

6 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

7 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
8 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
9 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby  
10 voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing in this matter.

11 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
12 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

13 3. The Licensee admits the violations set forth above and referenced in the AVN  
14 and complaint: On or about May 29, 2012, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof,  
15 refused to allow an inspection and/or obstructed a law enforcement officer in violation of  
16 RCW 66.28.090; 66.44.370; and WAC 314-11-090. Additionally the Licensee, or employee(s)  
17 thereof, were intoxicated on the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

18 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type for  
19 each violation within a twenty four month period, which carries a standard penalty of a five (5)  
20 day suspension of the license or a five hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty for each violation.

21 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300)  
22 for each of the above-referenced violations for a total of six hundred dollars (\$600) in lieu of a  
23 suspension.

24 6. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of six hundred dollars (\$600) no  
25 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent


4 7. In the event that the Licensee fails to make a full and timely payment of the  
5 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 6, then the standard penalty in Section II,

7 8. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are  
8 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full  
9 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced  
10 Complaint.

11 9. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
12 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.




