

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee NAVARRETE, ANTONIO ELOGIO d/b/a MAIN STREET MARKET hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 24,204. The above-referenced Licensee has since sold its business, but for the purposes of this action, is considered the Licensee and subject to the disciplinary action and a Final Order of the Board.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division served the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 4D2188B, alleging that the Licensee or employee(s) thereof gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person(s) under the age of twenty-one (21) in violation of RCW 66.44.270(1). The AVN

1 shows a two (2) year violation history and is cited as the first violation of its kind which  
2 reflects a penalty of five hundred (\$500) dollars or a five (5) day suspension of the license.

3 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
4 above-referenced AVN.

## 5 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

6 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

7 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
8 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
9 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby  
10 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

11 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
12 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

13 3. The Licensee admits the violation set forth above and referenced in the  
14 Complaint: On or about July 6, 2012, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, gave,  
15 sold and/or supplied liquor to a person(s) under the age of twenty-one (21), in violation of  
16 RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1).

17 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type  
18 within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of five  
19 hundred (\$500) dollars or a five (5) day suspension of the license.

20 5. The Licensee sold the licensed premise MAIN STREET MARKET and is no  
21 longer the current Licensee for MAIN STREET MARKET. The violation occurred on or  
22 about July 6, 2012 prior to the sale. The new Licensee is MERCADO EL RANCHO. The  
23 new License was first issued to MERCADO EL RANCHO on November 20, 2012 and the  
24 governing person of the business license is Maria Leticia Chaves. Antonio Elogio Navarrete is  
25 no longer a governing person on the new license.  
26

1           6.       In consideration for the stipulation to the violation as charged in the AVN and  
2 also in consideration that Licensee NAVARRETE, ANTONIO ELOGIO d/b/a MAIN  
3 STREET MARKET no longer is a governing person on the current license nor owns or  
4 operates any part of the licensed premises know as MERCADO EL RANCHO, there shall be  
5 no monetary penalty imposed for this violation.

6           7.       The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are  
7 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full  
8 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced  
9 Complaint.


10          8.       The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by


