

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and ISAAC WILLIAMSON, Assistant Attorney General, and CASA TAPATIA, INC. d/b/a CASA TAPATIA (Licensee) by and through PHILIP K. SAFAR, attorney for Licensee, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) Case Number 24,209.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued AVN No. 4I2212B to the Licensee, alleging that on or about July 30, 2012, the above-named Licensee or employee thereof, gave, sold, or otherwise supplied alcohol to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270.

**II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, the parties have agreed to resolve AVN No. 4I2212B via settlement. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1           1.       The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further  
2 litigation.

3           2.       The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all  
4 matters related to the above-referenced case and AVN. The Licensee hereby voluntarily  
5 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

6           3.       This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
7 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

8           4.       The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in AVN No. 4I2212B.  
9 Specifically, on or about July 30, 2012, the above-named Licensee or employee thereof, gave,  
10 sold, or otherwise supplied alcohol to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) in violation of  
11 RCW 66.44.270.

12           5.       The Licensee acknowledges that the above referenced violation is the  
13 Licensee's first violation of this type within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the  
14 standard penalty is suspension of the Licensee's liquor license for five (5) days or a monetary  
15 penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500).

16           6.       The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300)  
17 for the above-referenced violation.

18           7.       The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) no  
19 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. **Payment shall be**  
20 **sent to:**

24           8.       In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the  
25 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 7, the Licensee shall serve the standard  
26 penalty of a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and times of which shall be  
set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

1           9.     The Licensee further agrees that all of its employees will participate in a  
2 responsible liquor and tobacco sales class provided by Enforcement no later than sixty (60)  
3 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The Licensee is responsible for  
4 coordinating the date, time, and location of the training class through its assigned Liquor  
5 Enforcement Officer.

6           10.    The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
7 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.






