2 end on Monday (11:00 a.m.) April 21, 2014.


3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of five

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, FAMCO ENTERPRISES, INC. d/b/a FOUR CORNERS BAR & GRILL (Licensee), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Case No. 24,509, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2P2319c.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) charged Licensee with the following violation of Title 66 RCW and/or Title 314 WAC by its complaint dated June 6, 2013:

That on or around November 14, 2012, the above-named Licensee or an employee(s) thereof allowed an apparently intoxicated person(s) to possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premise, contrary to WAC 314-16-150 and RCW 66.44.200(1).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced Complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right to further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced violation, including the Complaint dated June 6, 2013.
9 Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth in the Complaint. Specifically,
13 the Licensee stipulates that on or around November 14, 2012, the Licensee and/or an employee
14 thereof allowed an apparently intoxicated person(s) to possess and/or consume liquor on the
15 licensed premise, contrary to WAC 314-16-150 and RCW 66.44.200(1).

16 5. The Licensee stipulates that this is the Licensee's second violation of this type
17 within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the standard penalty is suspension of the
18 Licensee's liquor license for seven (7) days.

19 6. The parties agree that the Licensee shall serve a three (3) day suspension of its
20 liquor license, for a consecutive period of three (3) days to begin on a Friday and to end on a
21 Sunday, for the violation stipulated to in Section II, Paragraph 4-5.

22 7. The parties agree that, in addition to the license suspension as set forth in Section
23 II, Paragraph 6, the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500) within
24 thirty (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board, **no later than 4:00 p.m. on the**
25 **applicable date**, for the violation stipulated to in Section II, Paragraph 4-5. **Payment shall be**
26 **sent to:**

4 8. In the event that the Licensee fails to undergo the suspension of its liquor license
5 as set out and required by Section II, Paragraph 6; and/or the Licensee fails to make the full and
6 timely payment of the monetary penalty as set out and required by Section II, Paragraph 7; the
7 Licensee shall be subject to a seven (7) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates of
8 suspension to be determined by the Board.

9 9. The parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the Board.

10 10. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Agreement are completely
11 read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full and final
12 compromise and settlement of any and all violations arising from the above-referenced AVN.


