

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

3 1. The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
4 litigation.

5 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
6 matters related to the above-referenced case and AVN. The Licensee hereby voluntarily
7 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

8 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
9 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

10 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the complaint dated November
11 27, 2013. Specifically, that on or around March 29, 2013, the above-named Licensee or
12 employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person(s) under twenty-one (21),
13 contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

14 5. The Licensee acknowledges that the above referenced violation is the
15 Licensee's first violation of this type within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the
16 standard penalty is suspension of the Licensee's liquor license for five (5) days or a monetary
17 penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500).

18 6. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) no
19 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. **Payment shall be**




