FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Liquor Control Board issued a complaint dated March 19, 2014, alleging that on or about August 15, 2013 the above-named Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (MAST) Permit Holder gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person(s) under twenty-one (21) years of age, in violation of RCW 66.24.270(1) and WAC 314-11-020(1).

2. The Permit Holder timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing.

3. The Permit Holder did not appear for the prehearing conference by telephone on June 11, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. nor request a continuance. Assistant Attorney General Chad Standifer represented the Enforcement Division of the Board.

4. On June 11, 2014, Administrative Law Judge Mark H. Kim entered his Order of Default, ordering that the Permit Holder was in default and dismissing the appeal.

5. No request to vacate the default was filed.

6. No petition for review was filed.

7. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises; NOW,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case 24,852 is adopted.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed in case 24,852 is sustained and that the MAST Permit privileges granted to Christina Roach, MAST Permit No. 120460876, are hereby suspended for a term of five (5) days. In lieu of a MAST Permit suspension, the Permit Holder may pay a monetary penalty in the amount of two-hundred dollars (\$200.00) due within 30 days of this order. If timely payment is not received, suspension will take place from 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 11, 2014 until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 16, 2014. Failure to comply with the terms of this order will result in further disciplinary action.

Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


