FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:


1. The Deputy Director /Acting Licensing Director of the Liquor Control Board issued a Statement of Intent to Renew Liquor License with Restrictions dated December 9, 2014 to the above-captioned Licensee. The intended restriction in section 3.5.1 states that "Minors will not be permitted on the licensed premises of Volume nightclub. The restriction is not considered voluntary and will be enforced by the WSLCB."
2. The Licensee submitted a limited request for a hearing intending to preserve the right to challenge the above-restriction if the City of Seattle sought review of the Board's decision. No request for a hearing was received from the City of Seattle. On February 11, 2015, the Licensee withdrew their hearing request.
3. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Statement of Intent to Renew Liquor License with Restrictions dated December 9, 2014 for LCB case 24,984 is ADOPTED.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that liquor license number 077973 for Chew Inc. d/b/a Volume is RENEWED WITH RESTRICTION: Minors will not be permitted on the licensed premises of Volume nightclub. The restriction is not considered voluntary and will be enforced by the WSLCB.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b)

serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


