STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys Robert Ferguson, Attorney General and Kim O'Neal, Senior Counsel and the Licensee, Blue Sky Investments, Inc., d/b/a Stonehenge ("Licensee"), represented by Gregory Scott, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number L-24,807.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated September 25, 2014, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about December 26, 2012, the Licensee and/or employee(s) thereof permitted a person engaged in disorderly conduct on the licensed premises; failed to control the conduct of the Licensee, employees and patrons on the premises; engaged in and/or allowed behavior that provoked conduct which presents a threat to public safety; failed to conduct the licensed

1 premises in compliance with Titles 9 and 9A, RCW, and/or permitted a disorderly person to
2 remain on the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(2); (3)(a), 3(b), 3(c).

3 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
4 above-referenced Complaint.

5 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

6 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

7 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
8 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
9 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
10 request for a hearing on the matter.

11 2. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced
12 Complaint. On December 26, 2014, the Licensee and/or employee(s) thereof engaged in
13 disorderly conduct on the licensed premises as alleged in the Complaint.

14 3. The original Administrative Violation Notice alleged that the disorderly conduct
15 by the Licensee and employees justified the imposition of an aggravated penalty of a 30-day
16 license suspension. In the time since the date of the incident, Liquor Enforcement Officers
17 have visited and inspected the licensed premises approximately 20 times and have not
18 observed any violations or problems, and there has been no complaint of disorderly conduct or
19 other violations since the incident involved in the above-referenced Complaint. As a result of
20 the Licensee having no further violations of liquor laws or regulations, the parties agree that
21 the standard range penalty for this violation is now the proper penalty.

22 3. The parties agree that as a second violation for a Licensee and/or an employee
23 of the Licensee engaging in disorderly conduct on the premises, the standard penalty is a 7-day
24 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license.


25 4. The parties agree that the standard penalty of a 7-day license suspension shall
26 be imposed against the Licensee. The Licensee will schedule with the Pasco Liquor


1 Enforcement Officers the dates to serve the 7-day license suspension, and the suspension will


