

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, ARYNA ANDERSON, Assistant Attorney General, and FREMONT MISCHIEF, INC. d/b/a FREMONT MISCHIEF (Licensee), by and through its representative, MICHAEL SHERLOCK, hereby enter into this Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Case Number: 24,847, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) 2C3259A.

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I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board issued an AVN alleging that on or around August 30, 2013, the above-named licensed craft distillery sold samples of spirits of its own production to persons for on-premises consumption, contrary to RCW 66.24.145 (2013) and/or WAC 314.28.050 (2012). After the AVN had been issued, the law has changed, allowing craft distilleries to sell samples of spirits. To recognize the violation of the rules as they existed at the time of the violation as well as the subsequent change in the law, Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced AVN.

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.

2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right to further administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation for LCB Case Number 24,847. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this case.

3. Enforcement agrees to convert the alleged violation in LCB Case Number 24,847 that "on or around August 30, 2013, the above-named licensed craft distillery sold samples of spirits of its own production to persons for on-premises consumption, contrary to RCW 66.24.145 (2013) and/or WAC 314.28.050 (2013)" to a written warning.

4. The Licensee admits that:

On or around August 30, 2013, Fremont Mischief, a licensed craft distillery, sold samples of spirits of its own production to persons for on-premises consumption, contrary to RCW 66.24.145 (2013) and/or WAC 314.28.050 (2012).

5. The parties agree that the Liquor Control Board will issue a written warning and no penalty will be assessed in this case.

1 6. The parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the
2 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

3 7. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
4 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.




