FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Liquor Control Board issued a complaint dated November 13, 2014, alleging that on or about May 15, 2012 the above-named Permit Holder gave, sold and/or served liquor to an apparently intoxicated person or persons and/or permitted an apparently intoxicated person or persons to possess or consume liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200, WAC 314-11-035 and WAC 314-16-150.
2. The Permit Holder timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing.
3. A prehearing conference was scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on December 29, 2014 with the Office of Administrative Hearings before Administrative Law Judge Gina L. Hale. The Permit Holder did not appear for the prehearing conference or timely request a continuance. Assistant Attorney General Aryna Anderson represented the Enforcement Division of the Board.
4. On December 30, 2014, Administrative Law Judge Gina L. Hale entered her Initial Order of Default Dismissing the Appeal of Chad Patch for Failure to Appear, ordering that the Permit Holder was in default and dismissing the appeal.
5. No request to vacate the default was filed.
6. No petition for review was filed.

7. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises; NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case L-24,854 is adopted.


IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed in case L-24,854 is sustained and that the MAST Permit privileges granted to Chad N. Patch, MAST Permit No. 120-430-277, are hereby suspended for a term of five (5) days. In lieu of a MAST Permit suspension, the Permit Holder may pay a monetary penalty in the amount of two-hundred dollars (\$200.00) due within 30 days of this order. If timely payment is not received, suspension will take place from 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 14, 2015 until 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 19, 2015. Failure to comply with the terms of this order will result in further disciplinary action.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A

petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


