

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

3 1. The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
4 litigation.

5 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
6 matters related to the above-referenced complaint. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws
7 its request for a hearing in this matter.

8 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
9 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

10 4. The Licensee admits to the violations set forth above: on or around January 2,
11 2014, the above-named Licensee or an employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to
12 a person under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1), WAC 314-11-020,
13 and/or WAC 314-16-150.

14 5. The Licensee acknowledges that the above referenced violation is the Licensee's
15 first violation within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the standard penalty is a \$500
16 fine or five (5) day suspension.

17 6. The Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) no
18 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. **Payment shall be sent**




