15 W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General, and
16 GOLDEN DYNASTY RENTON, INC., d/b/a GOLDEN DYNASTY RESTAURANT AND
17 BAR (Licensee), by and through its attorney, KENNETH H. CHANG, and the Board having
18 considered the Stipulated Settlement Agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to




STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement and Education Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General, and GOLDEN DYNASTY RENTON, INC., d/b/a GOLDEN DYNASTY RESTAURANT AND BAR (Licensee), by and through its attorney, KENNETH H. CHANG, hereby enter into this Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Case Numbers: L-25,014, L-25,015, L-25,016 and L-25,017, arising from Administrative Violation Notices (AVN) 2M4015A, 2M3341A, 2M3347B and 2M3363A, respectively.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the Licensee with the following alleged violations of Title 66 RCW and/or Title 314 WAC by way of complaints dated July 28, 2014. The complaints alleged:

Case No. L-25,014

On one or more occasions between issuance of the liquor license number 406798 with restrictions on April 29, 2013 and January 16, 2014, the above-named

1 Licensee or employee(s) thereof violated restrictions of the liquor license, in
2 violation of RCW 66.24.010.

3 **Case No. L-25,015**

4 On or about December 7, 2013, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof
5 engaged in and/or permitted disorderly conduct on the licensed premises, contrary
6 to WAC 314-11-015(3)(a) and/or (c);

7 On or about December 7, 2013, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof
8 refused or failed to admit a peace officer demanding to enter the licensed
9 premises, thereby failing to allow inspection of the license premises contrary to
10 RCW 66.28.090(2).

11 **Case No. L-25,016**

12 On or about December 13, 2013, the above-named Licensee or an employee(s)
13 thereof gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to an apparently intoxicated person,
14 contrary to RCW 66.44.200(1) and/or WAC 314-16-150; and/or

15 On or about December 13, 2013, the above-named Licensee or an employee(s)
16 thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person or persons under the age of
17 twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

18 **Case No. L-25,017**

19 On or about December 29, 2013, the above-named Licensee or an employee(s)
20 thereof permitted a person and/or persons to engage in lewd conduct contrary to
21 WAC 314-11-050.

22 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
23 above-referenced Complaints.

24 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

25 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

26 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and
expense of further litigation.

2. The Licensee explicitly waives its right to further administrative review of all
matters related to the above-referenced violations for LCB Case Numbers L-25,014, L-25,015,
L-25,016 and L-25,017. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its requests
for hearings in all of the above-referenced cases.

3. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in case number L-25,014.
Specifically, on one or more occasions between issuance of liquor license number 406798 with

1 restrictions on April 29, 2013 and January 16, 2014, the above-named Licensee or employee(s)
2 thereof violated restrictions of the liquor license, in violation of RCW 66.24.010.

3 4. Enforcement and the Licensee agree that the standard penalty for a first
4 violation for failure to follow license restrictions under RCW 66.24.010 is a five (5) day
5 suspension of the liquor license or a one thousand five hundred dollar (\$1,500.00) monetary
6 penalty.

7 5. The Licensee admits to the violations set forth in case number L-25,015.
8 Specifically:

9 On or about December 7, 2013, the above-named Licensee or employee(s)
10 thereof engaged in and/or permitted disorderly conduct on the licensed
premises, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(a) and/or (c);

11 On or about December 7, 2013, the above-named Licensee or employee(s)
12 thereof refused or failed to admit a peace officer demanding to enter the
licensed premises, thereby failing to allow inspection of the license
premises contrary to RCW 66.28.090(2).

13 6. In case number L-25,015, Enforcement and the Licensee agree that the standard
14 penalty for a first violation of allowing disorderly conduct contrary to WAC 314-11-015 is a
15 five (5) day suspension or a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) monetary penalty. Enforcement and
16 Licensee also agree that the standard penalty for a first violation of failure to allow inspection
17 under RCW 66.28.090(2) is a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) monetary penalty or a five (5) day
18 suspension of the liquor license.

19 7. The Licensee admits to the violations set forth in case number L-25,016.
20 Specifically:

21 On or about December 13, 2013, the above-named Licensee or an
22 employee(s) thereof gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to an apparently
intoxicated person, contrary to RCW 66.44.200(1) and/or WAC 314-16-
23 150; and/or

24 On or about December 13, 2013, the above-named Licensee or an
employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person or
25 persons under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).
26

1 8. In case number L-25,016, Enforcement and the Licensee agree that the standard
2 penalty for a first violation of giving, selling, and/or supplying an apparently intoxicated
3 person with alcohol contrary to RCW 66.44.200(1) and/or WAC 314-16-150 is a five (5) day
4 suspension or a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) monetary penalty. Enforcement and Licensee
5 also agree that the standard penalty for a first violation of provision of alcohol to a person
6 under twenty-one years of age is a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) monetary penalty or a five (5)
7 day suspension of the liquor license.

8 9. The Licensee admits to the violations set forth in case number L-25,017.
9 Specifically, on or about December 29, 2013, the above-named Licensee or an employee(s)
10 thereof permitted a person and/or persons to engage in lewd conduct contrary to WAC 314-11-
11 050.

12 10. In case number L-25,017, Enforcement and the Licensee agree that the standard
13 penalty for a first violation for allowing lewd conduct on the licensed premises contrary to
14 WAC 314-11-050 is a five (5) day suspension or a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) monetary
15 penalty.

16 11. Enforcement and the Licensee agree that the Licensee shall pay a total monetary
17 penalty of two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400.00) for Case numbers L-25,014,
18 L-25,015, L-25,016 and L-25,017.

19 12. The Licensee shall pay the penalty of two thousand four dollars (\$2,400.00) no
20 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent

1 13. If the Licensee subsequently fails to make a full and timely payment of the
2 penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 11, then the standard penalty of a thirty (30) day
3 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license shall be imposed.¹

4 14. The Parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the
5 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

6 15. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
7 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.


