
23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement in the above

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and ARYNA ANDERSON, Assistant Attorney General, and JOHN J. RODRIGUEZ BECERRA (Permit Holder), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) case number L-25,018.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division issued administrative violation notice (AVN) 1R4080A to the aforementioned Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (MAST) Permit Holder alleging that on or about March 21, 2014, the Permit Holder gave, sold and/or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one years of age contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1) and WAC 314-11-020(1).

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Permit Holder agree to the following:

3 1. The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further  
4 litigation.

5 2. The MAST Permit Holder explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
6 review of all matters related to the above-referenced AVN. The MAST Permit Holder hereby  
7 voluntarily withdraws his request for a hearing in this matter.

8 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
9 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

10 4. The MAST Permit Holder admits to the violation set forth in AVN 1R4080A.  
11 Specifically, that on or about March 21, 2014, the Permit Holder gave, sold and/or otherwise  
12 supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one years of age contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1) and  
13 WAC 314-11-020(1).

14 5. The MAST Permit Holder acknowledges that the above referenced violation is  
15 his first violation within a three-year period, for which the standard penalty is suspension of the  
16 MAST permit for five (5) days or a monetary penalty of two hundred dollars (\$200).

17 6. The MAST Permit Holder agrees to pay a monetary penalty of one hundred  
18 dollars (\$100) within thirty (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board, no later than  
19 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date, for the violation stipulated to in Section II, Paragraph 4.


