

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and ISAAC WILLIAMSON, Assistant Attorney General, and RUBY & HELEN INC. d/b/a MERIDIAN CORNER TEXACO (Licensee) by and through SON HO KWON, representative, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB), case number L-25,022.

I. INTRODUCTION

By way of complaint issued June 6, 2014, the Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement and Education Division alleged that on or about March 22, 2014, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person or persons under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

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1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the evidentiary hearing, the parties have agreed to resolve the above captioned
3 case. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

4 1. The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
5 litigation.

6 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
7 matters related to the above-referenced complaint and AVN. The Licensee hereby voluntarily
8 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

9 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 4. The Licensee admits to the violations set forth above: that on or about
12 March 22, 2014, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or
13 supplied liquor to a person or persons under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to
14 RCW 66.44.270(1).

15 5. The Licensee acknowledges that the above referenced violation is the
16 Licensee's first public safety violation within a twenty-four (24) month period, for which the
17 standard penalty is a \$500 fine or five (5) day suspension.

18 6. Licensee's employees shall participate in the Liquor Control Board's
19 Responsible Liquor Sales Class within sixty (60) days of the date the Liquor Control Board
20 issues its final order in this case.

21 7. The Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) no
22 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. **Payment shall be**


