FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Liquor Control Board issued a complaint dated June 6, 2014, alleging that on March 8, 2014, the above-named Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (MAST) Permit Holder served and/or sold liquor to an apparently intoxicated person on the licensed premises, and/or allowed an apparently intoxicated person to consume and/or possess liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-16-150.
2. The Permit Holder timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing.
3. A prehearing conference was scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on September 9, 2014 with the Office of Administrative Hearings before Administrative Law Judge Jane Cantor Shefler. The Permit Holder Jasmyn D. Meyers did not appear for the prehearing conference nor request a continuance. The Enforcement Division of the Board was represented by Assistant Attorney General Susie Giles-Klein.
4. On September 18, 2014, Administrative Law Judge Jane Cantor Shefler entered her Amended Initial Order of Default Dismissing Appeal for Failure to Appear, ordering that the appellant was in default and dismissing the appeal.

5. No request to vacate the default was filed.
6. No petition for review was received.
7. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the

Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises; NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case L-25,027 is adopted with the following changes and corrections: The spelling of the first name of the Permit Holder is corrected to "Jasmyn".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed in case L-25,027 is sustained and that the MAST permit privileges granted to Jasmyn D. Meyers are hereby suspended for a term of five (5) days. In lieu of a license suspension, the Permit Holder may pay a monetary penalty in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) due within 30 days of this order. If timely payment is not received, suspension will take place from 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 19, 2015 until 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 24, 2015. Failure to comply with the terms of this order will result in further disciplinary action.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


