FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Liquor Control Board issued a complaint dated November 24, 2014, alleging that on or about March 6, 2014, the Licensee had unauthorized alterations on its premises, including dance floor in the middle of the dining area, a pool table in the dining area, and DJ equipment in the front portion of the premises, contrary to WAC 314.02.025.
2. The Licensee timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing.
3. A prehearing conference was scheduled for February 3, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. before Administrative Law Judge Gina L. Hale. The Notice of the Prehearing Conference was mailed to the Licensee on January 9, 2015.
4. The Licensee did not appear for the prehearing conference nor request a continuance. Assistant Attorney General Aryna Anderson represented the Enforcement Division of the Board.
5. On February 19, 2015, Administrative Law Judge Gina L. Hale entered her Order Dismissing Appeal, holding that the Licensee was in default and dismissing the appeal.
6. No request to vacate the default was filed.

7. No petition for review was filed.

8. Before the Prehearing Conference was held, the Licensee Troy Selland, sold the premises.

A new license was issued to the new owner in September, 2014.


9. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case L-25,028 is adopted.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed in case L-25,028 is sustained. In consideration of the fact that the Licensee has sold the business and is no longer operating the licensed premises, no penalty will be scheduled or collected in connection with this case.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for

reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.

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
