

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, JUSTIN KJOLSETH, Assistant Attorney General, and FRONTIER TAVERN (Licensee), by and through its representative, KATHY GRIFFIN, hereby enter into this Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) Case Number L-25,337, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) 4H4204A.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the Licensee with the following alleged violation of Title 66.RCW in an AVN dated July 30, 2014. The AVN alleges:

On or around July 23, 2014, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof allowed a minor to remain in an area classified by the board as off-limits to any person under the age of 21 years in violation of RCW 66.44.310.

Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced AVN.

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.

2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right to further administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for hearing in this matter.

3. The Licensee admits to the above-referenced AVN. Specifically:

On or around July 23, 2014, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof allowed a minor to remain in an area classified by the board as off-limits to any person under the age of 21 years in violation of RCW 66.44.310.

4. Enforcement and the Licensee agree that the standard penalty under WAC 314-29-020 for a first violation of RCW 66.44.310 is a five (5) day suspension of the liquor license or five-hundred dollar (\$500) penalty in lieu of suspension.

5. Enforcement and the Licensee agree that the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) for the above matter and shall serve no suspension.

6. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) no later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

7. If the Licensee subsequently fails to make a full and timely payment of the penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 6, then the standard penalty of a five (5) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license shall be imposed.

8. Enforcement and the Licensee acknowledge that the Licensee is taking responsibility for the violation, has a long term history of compliance, is aware of the Board's penalty standards set forth in Chapter 314-29 WAC, and that aggravating and mitigating circumstances are evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

9. The Parties recognize that this Agreement is subject to approval by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

10. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.




