FINAL ORDER ON REVIEW
FOLLOWING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE
PROCEEDING

I. REVIEWERS' CONSIDERATION

1.1 Review. This matter comes before the Members of the Liquor Control Board to review the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Initial Order of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding entered by Presiding Officer Kjell C. Werner with the Liquor Control Board on April 17, 2015. The Initial Order is attached and incorporated into this Order by this reference.

1.2 On May 7, 2015, the Licensee timely filed a Request for Administrative Review of the Initial Order of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding.

1.3 On May 19, 2015, the Board entered its Order Scheduling Administrative Review of Initial Order of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding which was mailed to the parties on May 20, 2015. The Finance Division of the Board was provided an opportunity to file a Response to Request for Administrative Review by June 1, 2015, which the Financial Division timely filed.

1.4 Record of Proceeding. The entire record of this proceeding was presented to the Members of the Liquor Control Board for review and the entry of a final decision.

II. ORDER


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Presiding Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Initial Order are hereby adopted as the final decision of the Board.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED the Liquor Control Board Financial Division's recommendation to provide one opportunity to enter into a 10-month settlement agreement with the Licensee to schedule monthly payments for the outstanding balance while maintaining full compliance with the reporting and fee payments for all future reporting periods is APPROVED. The Licensee has 30-days to enter into a settlement agreement with the LCB Financial Division. If the Licensee does not agree to enter into a settlement agreement to include the terms above, then license suspension will be effective after 30 days of this order and will remain effective until the Licensee is in full compliance with any and all outstanding reports and/or fees.

RIGHTS OF REVIEW

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or

delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Sr. Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.

Service. This Order was served on you the day it was deposited in the United States mail. RCW 34.05.010(19).
