
12 The above-titled matter having come before the Board upon a Stipulated Settlement

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement and Education Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and SUSIE GILES-KLEIN, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee OUTLAWS SALOON, INC. d/b/a OUTLAWS SALOON, represented by JAMIE FORD, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. L-25,361.

I. INTRODUCTION

Enforcement charged the above-named Licensee in Administrative Violation Notice ("AVN") No. 3A4208A with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

On or about July 27, 2014, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, served and/or sold liquor to an apparently intoxicated person on the licensed premises, and/or allowed

1 an apparently intoxicated person to consume and/or possess liquor on the licensed premises,
2 contrary to WAC 314-16-150.

3 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
4 above-referenced AVN.

5 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

6 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

7 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
8 expense of further litigation.

9 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
10 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
11 request for a hearing in this matter.

12 3. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth above and referenced in the
13 AVN, specifically: On or about July 27, 2014, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s)
14 thereof, served and/or sold liquor to an apparently intoxicated person on the licensed premises,
15 and/or allowed an apparently intoxicated person to consume and/or possess liquor on the
16 licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-16-150.

17 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type
18 within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of five
19 hundred dollars (\$500.00) or a five (5) day suspension of the license.

20 5. In consideration of the Licensee's agreement not to pursue further
21 administrative review, the Washington State Liquor Control Board (the "Board") agrees to
22 reduce the monetary penalty to three hundred dollars (\$300). This amount shall be paid within
23 thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the Board. **Payment shall be made no later**
24 **than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date and sent to:**




