
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

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Licensing and Regulation Division ("Licensing") represented by its attorneys ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and SUSIE GILES-KLEIN, Assistant Attorney General, and the Applicant T & D WOOD LLC, d/b/a MR. DOUG'S FAMILY RESTAURANT ("Applicant") represented by its attorney CHARLES H. HOUSER III, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. L-25,367.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

On November 7, 2014, Licensing issued a Statement of Intent to Deny the Applicant's liquor license application no. 083374. The denial was based on the Applicant's failure to provide the necessary documents to Licensing pursuant to RCW 66.24.010(2), WAC 314-07-065(2), and WAC 314-12-035(1). The Applicant appealed the denial on November 24, 2014.

Licensing and the Applicant wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced Statement of Intent to Deny.

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**II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

Licensing and the Applicant agrees to the following:

1. Licensing and the Applicant enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.

2. The Applicant explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced Statement of Intent to Deny. The Applicant hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

3. The Applicant acknowledges that his application for a liquor license is denied pursuant to RCW 66.24.010(2), WAC 314-07-065(2), and WAC 314-12-035(1).

4. In consideration of Applicant's agreement not to pursue further administrative review, Licensing agrees to reduce WAC 314-07-050(2)'s one-year prohibition on reapplying for a liquor license by six months. Thus, the Applicant will be eligible to re-apply for a liquor license six months from the date of the final order of the Board.

5. This Settlement Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of the parties' agreement, and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

6. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full and final settlement of any and all claims arising from the above-referenced Statement of Intent to Deny.

7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the Board.

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


