
15 THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board

20 the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for case number
21 L-25,418, and the Board having considered the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and
22 Enforcement's Memorandum recommending acceptance of the Stipulated Settlement
23 Agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained
24 in this case, now therefore:

25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement in the above
26 captioned case is adopted in its entirety; and the AVN for case number L-25,418 is sustained.

2 relinquishing its license number 080174. Therefore, no license suspension shall be imposed in

STIPULATED
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General, and ARYNA ANDERSON, Assistant Attorney General, and JENNA, INC. d/b/a CELLARS RESTAURANT & LOUNGE (Licensee) by and through its attorney, DAVID OSGOOD, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) case number L-25,418.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division issued administrative violation notice (AVN) 2T4328A to the aforementioned Licensee alleging that on or about October 11, 2014, the Licensee and/or its employee(s) gave, sold and/or otherwise supplied liquor to a person or persons under twenty-one years of age and/or allowed a person or persons under twenty-one years of age to enter or remain in an area

1 classified as off-limits to any person under the age of twenty-one years, contrary to RCW
2 66.44.310, RCW 66.44.270, and WAC 314-11-020.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. The parties enter into this Agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
6 litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
9 request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in AVN 2T4328A. Specifically,
13 that on or about October 11, 2014, the Licensee or its employee(s) supplied liquor to a person
14 or persons under twenty-one years of age and/or allowed a person or persons under twenty-one
15 years of age to enter or remain in an area classified as off-limits to any person under the age of
16 twenty-one years, contrary to RCW 66.44.310, RCW 66.44.270, and WAC 314.11.020(2).

17 5. The Licensee acknowledges that the above referenced violation is the
18 Licensee's second violation within a two-year period, for which the standard penalty is
19 suspension of the liquor license for seven (7) days.

20 6. The Licensee recently sold Cellars Restaurant & Lounge thereby voluntarily
21 relinquishing its license number 080174. The new owners have applied for liquor licensure
22 and received a temporary permit. Therefore, this Licensee does not own or manage a
23 spirits/beer/wine restaurant at the aforementioned location any longer, making any suspension
24 of this liquor license a moot penalty.

7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.




