FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Licensing Division of the Liquor Control Board issued a Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License dated June 25, 2014 asserting that the Applicant's proposed location was within 130 feet of The Community School at 1300 W Knox Avenue in Spokane, WA; and the proposed location was within 715 feet of Trinity Catholic School and Trinity Educare Center at 1306 W Montgomery Avenue in Spokane, WA; and the proposed location was also within 940 feet of Little Scholars Learning Center at 2015 N Monroe Avenue in Spokane, WA.
2. The Applicant timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing.
3. A prehearing conference was scheduled for Monday, November 3, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. before Administrative Law Judge Johnette Sullivan with the Office of Administrative Hearings.
4. The Applicant did not appear for the prehearing conference or obtain a continuance. Assistant Attorney General Aryna Anderson represented the Licensing Division of the Board.

5. On November 4, 2014, Administrative Law Judge Johnette Sullivan entered an Initial Order or Dismissal, holding that the Applicant was in default and dismissing the appeal.

6. On November 7, 2014 a petition to vacate default was filed by the Applicant.

7. On January 21, 2015, Administrative Law Judge Johnette Sullivan entered an Order Denying Petition to Vacate.

8. No petition for review was received.

9. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case M-25,142 is adopted.


IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License for case M-25,142 in this matter is ADOPTED.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with

the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


