FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Licensing Division of the Liquor Control Board issued an Amended Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License dated February 3, 2015 asserting that the Applicant's proposed location is a residence, that the proposed location is approximately 960 feet from Children's Lab School at 412 South Oak Street in Centralia, WA, that the proposed location is approximately 970 feet from George Washington Park on South Pearl Street in Centralia, WA, and that Centralia Timberland Library at 110 South Silver Street in Centralia, WA is approximately 970 feet from the proposed location.

2. The Applicant timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing.

3. A prehearing conference was scheduled for March 10, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. before Administrative Law Judge Terry A. Schuh with the Office of Administrative Hearings.

4. The Applicant did not appear for the prehearing conference or obtain a continuance. Assistant Attorney General Aryna Anderson represented the Licensing Division of the Board.

5. On March 11, 2015, Administrative Law Judge Terry. A. Schuh entered an Order Dismissing Appeal, holding that the Applicant was in default and dismissing the appeal.

6. No motion to vacate default was received.

7. No petition for review was received.

8. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case M-25,168 is adopted.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License for case M-25,168 in this matter is ADOPTED.


AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that license application number 414707 for Marijuana Retailer for Charles Richard Tyson d/b/a Mumbles is DENIED.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with

the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


