1. The Licensing Division of the Liquor Control Board issued a Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License dated July 3, 2014 asserting that the Applicant failed to submit required documents to include a valid and signed letter of intent to lease or purchase from property owner or designee.

2. The Applicant timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing.

3. A prehearing conference was scheduled for December 11, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. before Administrative Law Judge Terry A. Schuh with the Office of Administrative Hearings.

4. The Applicant did not appear for the prehearing conference nor obtain a continuance. Assistant Attorney General Kim O'Neal represented the Licensing Division of the

Board.

5. On December 16, 2014, Administrative Law Terry A. Schuh entered an Order Dismissing Appeal, holding that the Applicant was in default and dismissing the appeal.

6. No motion to vacate default was received.

7. No timely petition for review was received.

8. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case M-25,264 is adopted.


IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License for case M-25,264 in this matter is ADOPTED.

Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


