The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Licensing Division of the Liquor and Cannabis Board issued a Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License dated March 11, 2015 asserting that the Applicant accrued 28 criminal points for failing to disclose the following:

- i. Making False Statement to Public Servant 2010
- ii. DUI 1997
- iii. DWLS 3rd Degree 1996
- iv. DWLS 3rd Degree 1995
- v. Driving While License Suspended 1995

vi. Resisting Arrest 1990

vii. Negligent Driving 1990

2. Licensing received the Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License back from the U.S. Postal Service which had been mailed to the business location address.

3. Licensing mailed another Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License dated March 26, 2015 to the Applicant's home mailing address. On May 4, 2015, the U.S. Postal Service returned the second mailing to WSLCB labeled as unclaimed.

4. On May 12, 2015, Licensing sent an e-mail to the Applicant requesting address verification and an alternate address to which no reply was received; therefore, no hearing request was received from the Applicant.

5. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises; NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Statement of Intent to Deny Marijuana License for case M-25,447 in this matter is ADOPTED.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the marijuana retailer license application for DM Weets LLC. d/b/a Wolverine Industries is DENIED.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with

the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


